CIS reserves the right to alter its fees at any time due to currency fluctuations and/or fee changes made by their partner universities. These fees are current as of February 21, 2008.

Please see notes on reverse. Dates and fees are subject to change- final dates and fees will be provided to applicants as available. Students attending more than one CIS program will receive a discount- contact CIS for details.

CIS Program Package: (Included in all of the above programs): full time tuition, housing, academic advising, financial aid counseling, pre-departure orientation, airport reception, host institution orientation, medical and accident insurance, official transcript, student fees, international cell phone (not available for Ireland & the Irish Winter Program), assistance with travel arrangements, and CIS support services before, during and after your program.

Excluded from program fees: Transportation to and from program location, passport and visa fees, meals (unless specified), utility costs (phone, electricity, etc.), books (unless specified), supplies, housing damage deposit, and personal spending money. After your acceptance CIS will provide you with a budget specifying all additional costs you should expect.

***Please note the details regarding prices for the following CIS programs:**

Middlesex University, 6 week program: The total program fee for students enrolling in 15 Middlesex credits is \$5,550; the program fee for 30 Middlesex credits is \$7,000; the program fee is 45 Middlesex credits is \$7,750.

Middlesex University, 3 week program: The total program fee for students enrolling in 15 Middlesex credits is \$4,450. The program fee for 30 Middlesex credits is \$6,100.

Northwest England Program plus Scotland/Ireland options: The cost of the Northwest England program plus a one week course in Scotland is \$6,950. The cost of the Northwest England program, a one week course in Scotland and a one week course in Ireland is \$9,750. Roundtrip airfare from the US and transfer from England to Scotland/Ireland are included. There may be additional fees for roundtrip airfare depending on departure city in the US.

Italy (all programs)- Some courses include on-site or hands-on components that include travel or museum visits, or require special materials. Additional fees apply for these subjects.

The Pantheon Center (Rome) and The Umbra Institute (Perugia)- The lower fee listed is for 3 credits, the higher fee is for 6 credits.

University of Auckland Winter Program: The total program fee for students enrolling in one subject is \$3,890. The program fee for two subjects is \$5,790.

University of Stirling: The program fee for Block 1 and 2 is \$7450 for 9 credits and \$8250 for 12 credits.

Spain (all programs)- Some courses include on-site or hands-on components that include travel or museum visits, or require special materials. Additional fees apply for these subjects.

Explanation of fees, insurance and housing

Tuition: Because you are considered an “international” student while you are studying abroad, immigration law states that you must be enrolled as a full time student. Keep in mind that the tuition included in the program fee is for general subjects, and some universities will charge extra for certain subjects (i.e. science, engineering, fine arts). If you register for these types of subjects and the university charges an additional fee, you will be charged the additional amount.

Program Fees: All program fees quoted are in U.S. dollars. Many institutions charge a mandatory student fee that we have included in our prices. In some cases, an optional activity fee is charged if students wish to use recreational facilities on campus. This is your responsibility and can be taken care of after arrival.

Health Insurance: Medical and accident insurance is provided for all students enrolled in CIS programs, the cost of which is included in the program fee. Students going to Australia for Bond University’s May semester will receive additional coverage through Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), which is required by the Australian government. For details on coverage, please contact CIS.

Housing: In all cases, housing is included in the CIS program fee. The type of housing ranges from residential halls (dorms) to university-managed apartments to homestays, and hostels and/or bed & breakfasts during program-related travel. Meals may or may not be included (see “Inclusions” on front side to see if meals are included in housing option). Extra charges may apply for telephone hook up, computer usage, etc. Meals are sometimes included in the *residence hall* option, and for some programs there is a meal plan option for an extra fee. *University apartments* typically offer a single or shared room with shared bathroom facilities, are typically within walking distance of the university, and will include facilities for cooking meals. Meals are generally not included, though for some there is a meal plan option for an extra fee. *Homestays* are with a family (Spain only) and include some meals.

Additional Inclusions: Because each student has different requirements for a study abroad experience, each CIS program is different. Any unique attributes that a program may possess are explained in the “Inclusions” column. Some universities offer excursions that are optional and are not included in the printed program fee. Students are welcome to sign up for these independently upon arrival at the host institution.
