West Haven, CT, February 19, 2007 - The Center for International Studies (CIS) has entered into a long-term strategic international academic partnership with the University of New Haven (UNH) to develop international programs that will serve to further the University's strategic internationalization goals and further strengthen the academic quality of CIS study abroad programs.

Under the terms of the partnership, CIS, located in Northampton, MA, will serve as the primary provider of international education abroad programs for the University of New Haven and will share its international program expertise with the University's faculty and administration to develop new and innovative global programs. An additional term of the partnership includes the provision that the University will act as the University of Record for all CIS programs.

Jeff Palm, Director and founder of CIS, says of the partnership, "We are very excited about this partnership with the University of New Haven, particularly since the internationalization of academic curriculum is one of their primary strategic goals and CIS has worked successfully with other universities to achieve this same result."

This announcement comes on the heels of the University of New Haven having gone through a rigorous exercise of verification by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges allowing it to be among the first universities in the country to have formal approval for recognizing a third party provider's study abroad programs.
